SURESHWAR THAKUR, J. (ORAL)

1. The writ petitioner becomes aggrieved from the Director of Consolidation, State of Punjab, not deciding the impleadment application (Annexure P-10), with which he is seized. He submits that the above has happened on account of the Director of Consolidation, State of Punjab, not holding Court.
2. If so, the co-respondent concerned, is directed to ensure that henceforth the Director of Consolidation, State of Punjab proceeds to regularly hold Courts, as he performs quasi judicial functions. The respondent concerned, is also directed to ensure that within two months from today a decision, in accordance with law, is made upon the petitioner's application seeking his impleadment in the relevant lis.
3. In view of the above, the instant petition is disposed of but with above directions.
