LISA GILL, J.

The petitioner, who is working on the post of Motor Mechanic Instructor, is aggrieved of reduction in his salary.

Though written statement has been filed in this writ petition, learned counsel for the State, on instructions from Suresh Kumar, Group Instructor/Incharge, Government ITI, Kalanaur, Rohtak, submits that a subsequent development has taken place wherein it has been decided to release the salary of Rs.35,400/- to the petitioner and furthermore sanction for release of arrears has also been given on 18.02.2022, therefore, this writ petition is rendered infructuous. A photocopy of the sanction order dated 18.02.2022, furnished in Court today, is taken on record, subject to just exceptions.

In view of the factual position as brought forth by learned counsel for the State, this writ petition is disposed of as infructuous.

Needless to say, petitioner is at liberty to file appropriate application within four weeks from today, in case any incorrect fact has been set forth.
