Learned counsel for the petitioner argues that though vide order dated 15.01.2019 (Annexure P-16), the petitioner has been granted promotion to the post of Principal retrospectively w.e.f. 18th/22th December, 1997 but the consequential benefits of revision of pay and pensionary benefits, have not been extended to the petitioner, which is causing prejudice to the petitioner as after the retrospective promotion, the pay as well as pensionary benefits of the petitioner is to be increased.

Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that the petitioner has already raised the said grievance before the respondents by serving upon them a legal notice dated 14.06.2022 (Annexure P-21), which is still pending consideration with the respondents and the petitioner will be satisfied, at this stage, in case a time bound direction is

issued to respondent No.3 to decide the said legal notice by passing an appropriate speaking order.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Harish Nain, learned Assistant Advocate General, Haryana, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents

Learned counsel for the respondents raises no objection in deciding the legal notice of the petitioner in a time bound manner by passing an appropriate speaking order.

Without commenting upon the merits of the case or about the entitlement of the petitioner for the relief which has been claimed by him in the legal notice dated 14.06.2022 (Annexure P-21), the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3 to decide the legal notice dated 14.06.2022 (Annexure P-21) within a period of eight weeks from the receipt of copy of this order. In case after the passing of the speaking order, the petitioner is found entitled for any benefit, the same be extended to him within a further period of four weeks.
