The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C., for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner, in case FIR No. 40, dated 13.06.2019, lodged under Sections 406, 498-A of IPC, registered at Police Station Women Commissionerate Jalandhar, District Jalandhar (annexed as Annexure P-1).

As per report received from the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court, to which the parties were referred to, the parties have amicably settled all their disputes by way of a settlement/agreement dated 13.12.2021, which is annexed with the said report.

Learned counsel further submits that pursuant to order dated 06th December, 2019, passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined investigation and cooperated with the investigating agency.

Learned State counsel assisted by learned counsel for the complainant, does not dispute the factum of the petitioner having joined investigation. He on further instructions submits that since the petitioner has joined investigation, his further investigation, much less, custodial interrogation is not required.

Learned counsel appearing for the complainant also does not dispute the factum of the compromise having indeed been effected between the parties.

Heard.

In view of the above, the petition is allowed and interim order dated 06th December, 2019, is made absolute subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
