HARSIMRAN SINGH SETHI, J. (ORAL)

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that after the last date of hearing, the respondents have released the pensionary benefits to the petitioner but there is certain dispute with regard to the calculations of the said benefits. Learned counsel submits that as the benefits have been released to the petitioner after a delay, the petitioner is also entitled for the grant of interest on the delayed release of the benefits.

Learned Senior counsel appearing on behalf of the respondents very fairly submits that in case the petitioner approaches the respondents by way of filing a representation with regard to the grievance regarding calculation of benefits or interest on the delayed release of the benefits, the same will be decided in accordance with law by passing an appropriate speaking order within a period of 8 weeks from the receipt of the same and in case, after passing of the said order, the petitioner is found entitled for any monetary benefit, the same will be extended to him within a period of 4 weeks thereafter.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the statement made by learned Senior counsel, no further grievance survives in the present petition and the same may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further with liberty as prayed for.

Ordered accordingly.
