The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No.145 dated 01.06.2022 registered under Sections 376(2)(n), 506, 34 IPC at Police Station Saha, District Ambala.

By virtue of the order dated 08.08.2022, while granting interim protection, the petitioner was directed to join investigation.

It has been contended by learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner has joined the investigation and fully cooperated and thus, the interim order may kindly be made absolute.
