The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for the grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.83 dated 11.03.2022 registered under Sections 323, 354, 452, 494, 498-A and 506 IPC at Police Station Chappar, district Yamuna Nagar.

On 08.08.2022, this Court had passed the following order : -

“Inter-alia relies on the grant of ad interim anticipatory bail to a similarly placed co-accused Devi Dyal who had earlier approached this Court through CRM-M-21589-2022 - Devi Dyal vs. State of Haryana.

Notice of motion.

Mr.Sumit Jain, Additional Advocate General, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State.

For arguments, adjourned to 05.09.2022.

To be heard along with CRM-M-21589-2022.

In the meanwhile subject to the petitioner’s joining investigation as and when called by the investigating agency as also abiding by the other conditions provided

under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C, in the event of her arrest in FIR No.83, dated 11.03.2022, registered under Sections 323, 354, 452, 494, 498-A, 506 IPC at Police Station Chappar, District Yamuna Nagar, she shall be released on ad interim anticipatory bail to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer.

Before the adjourned date the State shall file a concise status report which shall include the FIR in question.”

Learned State counsel submits that under the afore-quoted order passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined and cooperated with the investigation and that his custodial interrogation is not required by the State.

Through order of even date passed in CRM-M No.21589 of 2022 – Devi Dayal Vs. State of Haryana, this Court has granted anticipatory bail to similarly placed co-accused Devi Dayal.

In view of the afore statement made on behalf of the State and because similarly placed co-accused Devi Dayal has already been granted anticipatory bail by this Court, the interim order of this Court dated 08.08.2022, granting ad interim anticipatory bail to the petitioner is ordered to be made absolute.
