1. Prayer in the petition is for initiating proceedings against the respondents for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P-1, dated 20.04.2022, in CWP-7868-2022.

2. A perusal of order Annexure P/1 dated 20.04.2022, reveals that CWP-7868-2022, was disposed of by directing the respondent to consider and decide pending representation dated 17.04.2022, by passing a speaking order within twelve weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order.

3. At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner states that representation dated 17.04.2022, has been decided and the process of changing the date of birth of the petitioner as claimed in the representation initiated, therefore, in the circumstances, the petitioner is not interested in pursuing the instant petition and may be permitted to withdraw the same.

4. In view of the position noted above, as well as statement of learned counsel for the parties, the instant petition is *disposed of* as not

calling for any action against the respondent under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971.
