Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in the present case, vide advertisement dated 13.08.2016 (Annexure P/1/), 06 posts of Clerk were advertised by the respondents and after the result, the name of the petitioner appeared in the selected candidates list but, he has not been given offer of appointment. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner also needs to be appointed keeping in view the approval granted by the respondents dated 02.02.2018 (Annexure P/9).

After notice of motion, the respondents have filed reply. Learned State counsel submits that though, the petitioner was provisionally selected on the basis of written test but, keeping in view the number of vacancies advertised, the candidates who attained higher merit than the petitioner, were appointed.

Learned State counsel submits that as per his instructions

respondents are not intending to appoint the candidates beyond the number of posts advertised and further submits that in case the petitioner is relying upon any approval by the respondents, he can approach the respondents by way of filing an appropriate representation claiming the said benefit and in case any such representation is filed by the petitioner, the same will be decided in accordance with law by passing an appropriate speaking order within a period of 08 weeks.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the same, the present petition may kindly be disposed off having been not pressed any further with liberty as prayed for.

Ordered accordingly.
