Present petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution for quashing the impugned order dated 22.03.2018, received on 19.01.2019 (P-11), whereby services of the petitioner were terminated with allegations of absent from duties, without affording any opportunity of hearing, during the pendency of earlier writ petition (CWP No.22539 of 2017) filed by the petitioner.

Learned Counsel on instructions from petitioner submits that in view of the communication dated 11.08.2022, the Appellate Authority has fixed the date of hearing of appeal on 25.08.2022; thus, present petition be disposed off with liberty to pursue the statutory appeal.

Ordered accordingly.

Learned State Counsel on instructions has given an assurance that appeal shall be decided within four weeks.

In view of the above, learned Appellate Authority is requested to decide the appeal in accordance with law, expeditiously, but not later than 30.09.2022.
