The instant petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of the India for issuance of a writ in the nature of Mandamus directing the respondents to release the assured and sanctioned capital subsidy of Rs.10,66,400/- alongwith interest.

Learned State Counsel has apprised the Court that the entire principal amount of sanctioned capital subsidy has been released in favour of the petitioner and inasmuch as the claim of the petitioner qua interest is concerned, the petitioner has himself waived off his right qua the same. She has handed over today in Court a copy of letter dated 01.07.2019 issued by the petitioner in this regard.

The aforesaid letter and/or assertion made by the learned State counsel is not controverted by the learned counsel for the petitioner.
