Prayer in the present petition is for issuance of directions to respondent Nos. 2 to 5 for proper investigation or transfer the investigation of FIR No. 180 dated 21.06.2022, registered under Sections 147, 148, 323, 341, 506 IPC and later on added Section 307 IPC, at Police Station Nathu Sarai Chopta, District Sirsa, to some independent agency like Crime Branch or Special Investigation Team headed by some senior officer of the rank of IG and also to provide protection to the petitioner at the hands of the private respondents.

On the last date of hearing, learned State counsel was directed to assist this Court.

Today, learned State counsel submits that during inquiry conducted by the Deputy Superintendent of Police, 4 accused were found

innocent, 02 have been arrested, 01 is on anticipatory bail and the remaining 02 accused have also applied for bail and the investigation is going on in a proper manner.

I have heard the learned counsel for the parties.

As submitted by the learned State counsel, out of 09 persons named in the FIR, 04 have found innocent in the inquiry conducted by the Deputy Superintendent of Police, 02 have been arrested. This Court is of the view that the investigation is going on in a proper manner and thus, no indulgence of this Court in the present case is called for.

In view of the above, the present petition is dismissed.
