The petitioner is before this Court seeking regular bail in case of FIR No. 62 dated 24.6.2021, under Sections, 22/29 of NDPS Act, 1985, registered at Police Station Moonak District Sangrur.

Recovery from the petitioner was of 1690 intoxicant tablets. The recovery falls within the commercial quantity. The bail was sought on the ground that there is non compliance of Sections 42 and 50.

Learned State counsel opposes the prayer for bail on the ground that the recovery is of commercial quantity and the petitioner is involved in two more cases under the NDPS Act.

At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioner realizing that the contentions are not finding favour and sensing an adverse order, seeks permission to withdraw the present petition.

Dismissed as withdrawn.
