The petitioner is seeking to quash the impugned orders dated 29.07.2022 and 08.03.2022 passed by the Court of Learned Principal Judge, Family Court, Pathankot and also issuance of directions to Learned Family Court to conclude the application under Section 340 Cr.P.C. expeditiously.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that in terms of the order dated 29.07.2022, the conditional warrants of arrest of the petitioner have been issued for 15.10.2022 and it has also been directed that in the event of the payment of Rs. 24,200/- is made, he may not be arrested. It has been stated that an amount of Rs. 21,000/- has already been paid by the petitioner and due to some health issues of the father of the petitioner, he is unable to make the payment, immediately. Learned counsel for the petitioner has restricted his prayer only to the extent that he may be given a period of 2 months to pay the amount of Rs. 24,200/-

to the respondent or deposit the same in the Court. With this limited prayer, he seeks to withdraw the petition.

In view of the above, the present petition stands dismissed as withdrawn. However, it is directed that the conditional warrants of arrest issued in terms of the order dated 29.07.2022 shall remain in abeyance till 15.10.2022, i.e. next date of hearing fixed in the trial Court to facilitate the petitioner to make the payment of balance amount of Rs. 24,200/-. It is made clear that in the event, the said amount of Rs. 24,200/- is not paid by the petitioner to the respondent or deposited in the Court on or before 15.10.2022, there will not be any bar for the learned Family Court to proceed further against the petitioner for realisation of the amount by issuing conditional warrants of arrest in accordance with law.
