The instant petition has been filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking for issuance of an appropriate writ directing the respondent No.3 to carry out correction in the name of the petitioner from “Sukhdev Kaur” to “Sukhdeep Kaur” in the Birth Certificate.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner contends that the petitioner was born in village Kalsian, Tehsil Raikot, District Ludhiana and completed her matriculation from Shaheed Kuldeep Singh Govt. Senior Secondary School, Nathowal, District Ludhiana in the year 2017 and Senior Secondary in the year 2019. She applied for the Birth Certificate in the year 2021 and annexed the entire requisite documents alongwith the application where her name was mentioned as “Sukhdeep Kaur”. However, when the Birth Certificate was received, the name was mentioned as “Sukhdev Kaur” instead of “Sukhdeep Kaur”.

Learned counsel contends that he has already served a legal notice (Annexure P-6) dated 11.03.2002 with the respondent-authorities to which a reply was received on 29.03.2022. Thereafter, the response was also furnished by the petitioner on 24.06.2022 and that he would be satisfied in case a detailed speaking order is passed by the respondent No.3-District Registrar, Birth and Deaths-cum-Civil Surgeon, Ludhiana after affording an opportunity of hearing to the petitioner to make good her case.

Notice of motion.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf the respondent-State has no objection to the petition being disposed of in order to enable respondent No.3-District Registrar, Birth and Deaths-cum-Civil Surgeon, Ludhiana to pass a reasoned and speaking order on the grievances espoused by the petitioner through the representation appended along with the present petition.

Accordingly, the present petition is disposed of with the consent of the parties directing respondent No.3-District Registrar, Birth and Deaths-cum-Civil Surgeon, Ludhiana to pass a reasoned speaking order after granting an opportunity of hearing to the concerned and effected parties within a period of 03 months of the receipt of certified copy of the present order.
