[1] Prayer in the instant petition is for initiation of proceedings against the respondent for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P/1 dated 14.07.2022 in CRWP No. 6698 of 2022.

[2] Learned AAG has produced compliance report by way of affidavit of the respondent along with report, Annexure R-1/T. The same is taken on record. Copy thereof is already stated to have been supplied to learned counsel for petitioner.

[3] In view of the report, Annexure R-1/T as approved by the Senior Superintendent of Police, Hoashiapur on 11.08.2022 recording no merit or threat to the petitioner having been substantiated, learned counsel for the petitioner states that he does not press the instant petition but prays for grant of liberty to the petitioner to challenge report, Annexure R-1/T as referred to above by way of appropriate proceedings in accordance with law.

[4] In view of the position noted above as well as the statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is *disposed of* as

not calling for any action against the respondent under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 while granting liberty to the petitioner as prayed for.
