Petitioner Company has invoked the jurisdiction of this Court under Article 227 of the Constitution of India challenging the order dated 06.07.2022 (Annexure P8) and order dated 08.06.2022 (Annexure P5) passed by the Court of learned Civil Judge (Junior Division), Gurugram whereby the application moved by the petitioner under Order 39 Rules 1 and 2 CPC has not been considered.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner and perused the relevant material on record.

After arguing for some time, learned senior counsel submits that he would be satisfied if the trial Court is directed to decide the application moved by the petitioner under Order 39 Rules 1 and 2 CPC at the earliest.

In the circumstances, the trial Court is directed to decide the application moved by the petitioner under Order 39 Rules 1 and 2

CPC expeditiously, i.e. on or before the next date of hearing i.e. 20.09.2022 which is already fixed for consideration of application under Order 7 Rule 11 read with Section 151 CPC, in accordance with law.

The revision petition stands disposed off in those terms.
