The instant writ petition has been filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari for quashing the impugned order dated 26.01.2014, Annexure P-10, whereby the claim of the petitioner for promotion as Assistant Sub Inspector has been denied.

Counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner would contend that the petitioner is entitled to the said promotion on account of the fact that he was involved in anti-terrorist encounters which are more than 10 in number. It is submitted that the petitioner herein would be satisfied at the present moment in case his claim is put up before the Officers' Grievances Committee which has now been newly constituted under orders of the High Court.

Learned State counsel raises no objection to the suggestion as made.

Consequently, this writ petition is disposed of by placing the entire matter pertaining to the claim of the petitioner for promotion to the rank of ASI and consequent ranks thereafter before the Officers' Grievances Committee constituted under the orders of the High Court, leaving it open to the petitioner to challenge any order so passed.
