The instant petition has been filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure seeking direction to respondents No.2 & 3 for reinvestigation of the FIR and for a further direction that a supplementary challan be filed since the police has submitted a cancellation report in the matter, by constituting a Special Investigation Team under the Supervision of Director General of Police (Crime) Haryana in case bearing FIR No. 0168 dated 20.10.2020 registered under Sections 323, 324, 34 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 (Section 326 of the IPC was added later on) at Police Station Guhla, District Kaithal.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the Investigating Agency has not conducted a fair investigation and has not taken note of the evidence that was submitted before the Investigating Officer and has thus wrongly filed a cancellation report before the Illaqa Magistrate after much delay. He thus contends that the said

circumstances necessitate investigation of the present case to be conducted by constituting a Special Investigation Team and under the direct supervision of Director General of Police (Crime).

I am of the opinion that such a contention raised on behalf of the petitioner cannot be accepted at this stage. A concluded investigation report already stands filed and the petitioner, if aggrieved of the conclusion so drawn by the Investigating Agency, is at liberty to file his protest before the Illaqa Magistrate and also move appropriate application before the Illaqa Magistrate for further investigation.

The present petition is thus dismissed as being without any merit and taking into consideration that an efficacious alternative remedy is already available to the petitioner to take recourse to for redressal of his grievance.
