[1] Prayer in the instant petition is for initiation of proceedings against the respondent for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P-1, dated 28.01.2021, in CWP No.1883 of 2021 in case titled as 'Hardeep Singh and anotherversusState of Punjab and others'.

[2] A perusal of order (Annexure P-1), reveals that CWP No.1883 of 2021, was disposed of by directing the respondent to take a decision on the complaint dated 31.05.2020 filed by the petitioner, as expeditiously as possible.

[3] Learned counsel for the petitioner states that in view of order (Annexure R-1/T) dated 26.04.2021 attached with reply filed on behalf of the respondent, the petitioner does not wish to pursue the instant petition and may be permitted to withdraw the same with liberty to challenge order (Annexure R-1/T) dated 26.04.2021 by way of appropriate proceedings in accordance with law.

[4] In view of the position noted above, as well as statement of

learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is *disposed of* as not calling for any action against the respondent under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, while granting liberty to the petitioner as prayed for.
