Petition herein, *inter alia*, is for issuance of a writ in the nature of Mandamus for directing the respondents to regularize the services of the petitioner w.e.f. 01.10.2003.

2. Though the matter is pending since last 6 years, learned counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner is sanguine that in case the legal notice dated 25.05.2016 (Annexure P-7) is decided, a favorable order will be passed as the petitioner is fully eligible for regularization on the post of Class IV daily wage. He suggests that a decision be taken by the competent authority, either way, on the pending legal notice dated 25.05.2016 (Annexure P-7) in accordance with law by passing a speaking order.

3. Learned State counsel is also in agreement with the course suggested by the learned counsel for the petitioner.

4. Given the nature of order being passed, there is no necessity to seek return by any of the respondents as no further proceedings and/or pleadings are required.
5. Without commenting on the merits of the case, the instant writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondents to look into the pending legal notice dated 25.05.2016 (Annexure P-7) of the petitioner and pass an administrative order, in accordance with law.
6. Let the needful be done as expeditiously as possible but in any case not later than 2 months.
7. Disposed of accordingly.
