HARSIMRAN SINGH SETHI J. (ORAL)

In the present petition, the petitioner is praying for the release of the pensionary benefits for which he is entitled for keeping in view the fact the petitioner attained the age of superannuation and retired on 30.04.2014.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that during the pendency of the present petition, the departmental proceedings pending against the petitioner were dropped and the petitioner has been released all the pensionary benefits so far and only claim of the petitioner which survive is for the grant of interest.

Learned State counsel submits that not only the departmental proceedings but criminal proceedings are also pending against the petitioner in the shape of FIR No.323 dated 15.01.2012, which is still pending where the petitioner is an accused.

Faced with this situation, learned counsel for the petitioner prays that the present petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further with liberty to the petitioner that in case he is exonerated in the criminal proceedings, he can raise his claim for the grant of interest.
