[1] Prayer in the petition is for initiating action against the respondent for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P/1 dated 07.01.2020 in Appeal No. A/60015/2020-SM/BR passed by Member (Judicial), Custom, Excise and Service Tax Appellate Tribunal, Chandigarh.

[2] At the outset learned counsel for the petitioners contends that payment as per entitlement in terms of order, Annexure P/1 dated 07.01.2020 has been made by the respondent to the petitioners, therefore, in the circumstances, the petitioners are not interested in pursuing the instant petition and may be permitted to withdraw the same.

[3] In view of the position noted above as well as the statement of learned counsel for the petitioners, the contempt petition is disposed of as not calling for any action against the respondent under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971.

[4] Rule discharged.

[5] All pending applications also stand disposed of.
