This is a petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking issuance of a writ of certiorari quashing the impugned award dated 27.02.2017 (Annexure P-1) passed by respondent No.1, with a further prayer that the said impugned order be stayed during the pendency of the writ petition.

The matter was referred to the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court. It has been reported by the Mediator of the Mediation Centre that the matter has been amicably settled between the parties.

As per the settlement, the parties have amicably settled their dispute under which petitioner/employer shall pay a lump-sum amount of Rs.20,000/- to respondent No.2-workman towards full and final settlement of his claim.

The representative of the petitioner has brought a demand draft bearing No.015632 dated 22.07.2022 for an amount of Rs.20,000/- in the name of respondent No.2-workman and the same is handed over to respondent No.2-workman, who is present in the Court.

In view of the above, the present petition is disposed of as having been rendered infructuous.
