The instant petition has been filed seeking to challenge order dated 10.07.2017 (Annexure P-2) passed by respondent No.3, whereby the petitioner stood transferred from Police District Jalandhar to Police District Sangrur, claiming that the same was contrary to the Punjab Police Rules, 1934.

There is no representation on behalf of the petitioner today.

Even on the last three dates of hearing, there was no representation on behalf of the petitioner.
