Learned counsel for the petitioners argues that both the petitioners have retired from service but, they are being harassed by respondent No.1 as respondent No.2-Haryana Financial Corporation by shifting the duty to release the pensionary benefits of the petitioner one another. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that in the tussle between respondents No.1 and 2 on the said issue and the petitioners are suffering as they are not being paid their pensionary benefits despite rendering approximately three decades of service. Prayer of the petitioners is for issuance of a direction to the respondents to grant the pensionary benefits to the petitioners in respect of the services, which they have rendered with respondents No.1 and 2.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners have already raised the said grievance before the respondents by way of

serving a legal notice dated 03.08.2020 (Anneuxre P/19), which is still pending consideration with the respondents and the petitioners will be satisfied, at this stage, in case a time bound direction is issued to respondent No.1 to decide the said legal notice by passing appropriate speaking order.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Raman Kumar Sharma, Addl. A.G. Haryana, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of respondent-State and raises no objection in deciding the legal notice dated 03.08.2020 (Anneuxre P/19) in a time bound manner by passing an appropriate speaking order.

In view of the above, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case or the claim being made by the petitioners in legal notice dated 03.08.2020 (Anneuxre P/19), respondent No.1 is directed to decide the legal notice dated 03.08.2020 (Anneuxre P/19) by passing a speaking order within a period of eight weeks from the date of receipt of copy of this order. In case after the decision, it is found that the petitioners are entitled for any benefit, the same will be extended to them within a period of next four weeks.

Present writ petition stands disposed of.
