As per the contents of the application, appellant No.1-Gurmeet Kaur wife of late Kulwant Singh had died on 09.05.2021 leaving behind Lovepreet Singh-appellant No.2 and Harjit Singh-appellant No.3 as her only legal heirs.

Since LR's of appellant No.1-Gurmeet Kaur are already on record as appellant Nos. 2 and 3, there is no requirement for sending notice to them.

Civil Misc. Application is allowed. Appellant Nos. 2 and 3 already on record be treated as LR's of appellant No.1 since deceased.

FAO-1289-2010

This is claimants' appeal seeking modification of award dated 24.04.2009 passed by the MACT, Patiala.

On request, the instant matter is taken up in National Lok Adalat accordingly discussed.

As per statements of learned counsel for the appellants, learned counsel for the Insurance Company and representatives of the respondent – Insurance Company (separately recorded), a sum of Rs.1,20,000/- (Rupees One lakh twenty thousand only) over and above the amount awarded by

the Tribunal is allowed to the appellants in full and final settlement of the claim in this appeal. As per the statement of learned counsel for the appellants, the enhanced amount be paid to appellants.

Accordingly, we dispose off this case with a direction to the Insurance Company to deposit a crossed-cheque for Rs.1,20,000/- (Rupees One lakh twenty thousand only) in the name of appellants with the office of the Lok Adalat of the High Court within a period of four weeks from today, in compliance of this order, failing which, interest @ 9% per annum shall follow on this amount till payment from the date of this order. The concerned Officer of the Lok Adalat Branch/Office shall issue proper receipt after receiving the cheque to learned counsel/representative of the respondent –Insurance Company. The appellant(s)' counsel/appellant(s) may collect the cheque from the office of the Lok Adalat.

Copy of the order be supplied/sent to the counsel/parties and file be returned to the Hon'ble High Court.
