Present petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari for setting aside the impugned order dated 26.06.2015 (P-5), passed by respondent No. 1 as well as directing the respondents to grant higher pay scale of 04/09/2014 to the petitioner from 01.01.1998 to 01.01.2003 and 01.01.2010 respectively.

Learned counsel, on instructions, while making reference to *para 9* of the affidavit, submits that grievance of the petitioner is redressed.

In view of the fair stand taken by learned counsel for the petitioner, the petition is disposed off as having been rendered infructuous.
