Mr. Lamba, learned counsel for the petitioner states that the revision petition arises from an order dated 08.04.2021 (Annexure P-10) passed by the Addl. District Judge, Gurugram, whereby the order dated 11.02.2021 (Annexure P-8) passed by the Civil Judge (Jr. Divn.), Gurugram dismissing the plaintiff's (petitioner) application under Order XXXIX Rules 1 and 2 CPC in a suit for permanent injunction was upheld. He states that during the pendency of the revision petition, the parties who are co-sharers have been put in separate possession of the suit property after partition of the land in accordance with law.

In view of the above stand of the learned counsel for the petitioner, the revision petition is rendered infructuous.

Dismissed as infructuous.
