This application has been moved on behalf of the applicant-petitioner for seeking permission to place the copy of the order dated 05.07.2017 passed by learned Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Amritsar, on the record as Annexure P-4.

2. Notice in the application.
3. Mr. Iqbal Singh Mann, learned Deputy Advocate General, Punjab, who has appeared in this case in pursuance of the copy of the instant application having been sent to the respondent-State in advance, accepts the notice and submits that he has no objection in allowing the instant application.
4. Keeping in view the above-said fact as well as the reasons as

mentioned in the present application, the same is allowed and Annexure P-4 is taken on the record.

After arguing for a while, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks permission to withdraw the present petition while submitting that the petitioner would surrender before the trial Court within one week positively and would move an application there for seeking the relief of regular bail and he further prays that the trial Court be directed to decide the bail application of the petitioner within some specific time-frame.

6. Learned State counsel has no objection to the above-discussed submission as well as the prayer as made by learned counsel for the petitioner.

Resultantly, the petition in hand is hereby dismissed for having been withdrawn with a direction to the trial Court concerned that in case the petitioner surrenders before it within the afore-stipulated period and moves any application for seeking the relief of regular bail, the same be decided in accordance with law, in the given set of the facts and circumstances of the case, within 04 (four) days thereafter.
