In the present petition, grievance of the petitioner is that as he has not been extended the benefit of the marks for experience, which was to be given to him in respect of his Experience Certificate (Annexure P-4), keeping in view the condition mentioned in the Advertisement dated 20.07.2019 (Annexure P-1), though he was fully entitled for the grant of said benefit, therefore, the respondents are liable to be directed to re-calculate the merit of the petitioner by granting him the said benefit of 07 marks for experience.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the same grievance has also been raised by the petitioner before the respondent by filing representation dated 06.06.2022 (Annexure P-6), which is still pending consideration with the authorities concerned and the petitioner will be satisfied at this stage, in case a time bound direction is given to the respondent to decide the representation dated 06.06.2022, by passing an appropriate speaking order.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of this case and without going into merits of the claim as raised by the petitioner in the present case as well as in the representation dated 06.06.2022 (Annexure P-6), this petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondent to pass an appropriate speaking order on the representation dated 06.06.2022 (Annexure P-6), filed by the petitioner, within a period of eight weeks from the date of receipt of the copy of this order.
