This is a petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking issuance of a writ of mandamus directing the respondent-Bank to appoint the petitioner on compassionate ground on an appropriate post on account of death of his father, who was working as Gunman and died while in service.

At the outset, counsel for the petitioner submits that, at this stage, the petitioner would be satisfied if the respondents take a conscious decision on the representation of the petitioner dated 14.02.2020 (Annexure P-4) and pass a speaking order thereon, within a time bound frame.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Gaurav Goyal, Advocate, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents. Even counsel for the respondents is not averse to the expeditious disposal of the claim of the petitioner.

In view of the above, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent Nos.1/2 to decide the representation of the petitioner dated 14.02.2020 (Annexure P-4) and take a conscious decision thereon by passing a speaking order; within a period of three months from the date of receipt of the certified copy of this order.
