The instant petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India with a prayer for issuance of a writ in the nature of Mandamus directing the respondent No.2 to conduct an independent inquiry into the representation dated 07.11.2019 (Annexure P-14) since there are specific allegations on the high level police officials with regard to connivance and malpractice.

After arguing for some time, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks permission to withdraw the instant petition with liberty to take recourse to the alternative remedies available to him in accordance with law.

Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty as aforesaid.
