The instant writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking invocation of writ jurisdiction of this court for directions to the respondents to allow the petitioner to run his clinic as well as the hospital and institute of paramedical sciences in accordance with the provisions of the Regulations of the Medical Council and not to unnecessarily harass the petitioner in the wake of inquiry conducted by the Chhattisgarh's State Police.

At the stage of issuance of notice of motion on 09.08.2022, contention of learned counsel for the petitioner has been recorded to the effect that their petition to be disposed of in view of the decision rendered in ***CWP No. 6339 of 2022 decided on 04.04.2022 titled as Vineet Kumar and others versus State of Haryana and others.***

Learned Advocate General, Haryana appears on behalf of the respondents contend that he has no objection in case the present petition be disposed of in terms of the order dated 04.04.2022 passed in ***CWP No. 6339 of 2022 titled as Vineet Kumar and others versus State of Haryana and others.***

Accordingly, the present petition is disposed of with the consent of the parties in terms of the order dated 04.04.2022 passed in ***CWP No. 6339 of 2022 titled as Vineet Kumar and others versus State of Haryana and others.***

The memo of parties shows that the Haryana State Pharmacy Council is not a party. On the oral request of the plaintiff, Haryana State Pharmacy Council is impleaded as respondent No. 6. The Advocate General Haryana has no objection to such impleament. Sh. Gopal Sharma, Advocate who is present in the Court accepts notice on behalf of respondent No. 6 and has no objection to the petition being disposed of in terms of the statement made by Advocate General, Haryana.

The petitioner undertakes to appear before the Registrar-Haryana State Pharmacy Council for representing the case on 16.12.2022 at 11:00 A.M., who shall dispose of the representation Annexure P-24 after affording proper opportunity to the respective parties.
