[1] Prayer in the instant petition is for initiation of proceedings against the respondents for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P-4, dated 01.10.2020, in CWP No.14662 of 2020 in case titled as '**Dharambir Sharma**versus**State of Haryana and others**'.

[2] At the outset, learned counsel states that in view of needful having been done by respondent No.1 and possession of the land in question having been handed over to the concerned Gram Panchyat in compliance of order (Annexure P-4) dated 01.10.2020 in CWP No.1466 of 2020, the petitioner is not interested in pursuing the instant petition and may be permitted to withdraw the same.

[3] In view of the position noted above, as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is *disposed of* as not calling for any action against the respondents under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971.
