Prayer is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in criminal case having FIR No.124 dated 30.3.2021 registered under Sections 148, 149, 323, 452, 506 IPC (Sections 201, 308 IPC added later on) at Police Station Sadar Thanesar, District Kurukshetra.

Counsel for the petitioners submits that initially, the FIR was registered under Sections 148, 149, 325, 452, 506 IPC and the petitioners were granted bail by the Court of learned Additional Sessions Judge. However, the police after completion of investigation, presented the challan by adding offence under Sections 201, 308 IPC and the petitioners apprehending their arrest, have moved the present petition and they have already joined the investigation with the police in pursuance of order of interim bail dated 8.8.2022 passed by Coordinate Bench of this Court.

State counsel on instructions from ASI Sudesh Kumar has

admitted that the petitioners have joined the investigation and further

submits that now the petitioners are not required by the police for any further investigation or custodial interrogation.

In view of the above, without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and order of interim bail dated 8.8.2022 is hereby made absolute subject to the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
