The petitioner seeks grant of anticipatory bail under Section 438 Cr.P.C in a case FIR No.81 dated 23.04.2022 registered under Sections 379-B(2), 386 IPC at Police Station Tarn Taran, District Tarn Taran.

A short reply dated 31.08.2022 has been filed on behalf of the respondent-State by the learned State counsel by way of an affidavit of Manjit Singh, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, (Headquarters), Additional Charge of Sub Division Tarn Taran, District Tarn Taran and the same is taken on record.

The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of the order dated 08.08.2022, petitioner has joined the investigation to the entire satisfaction of the Investigating Officer.

The learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Hakam Singh admits the aforesaid fact and submits that the petitioner is no more required for further investigation in the case.

In view of aforesaid factual position, the interim order dated 08.08.2022 is made absolute. However, the petitioner shall keep on joining the investigation as and when required to do so and she shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Petition stands disposed of.
