The petitioner prays for issuance of a writ in the nature of Mandamus, directing respondent no.1 to 5 to pay compensation for having utilized his land in order to construct a hospital. The respondent-State is disputing the ownership of the petitioner. Various affidavits have been filed by the State of Punjab to that effect.

Learned counsel representing the petitioner submits that the verified copy of the order, proving that the petitioner was allotted some other piece of land, has not been produced.

In the considered view of this Court, the writ petition involves disputed questions of facts, which are required to be proved by leading evidence. Hence, the writ petition is disposed of while relegating the petitioner to the alternative remedy.
