This is an application for placing on record the written statement on behalf of respondent No.1.

For the reasons mentioned in the application, the same is allowed and the written statement on behalf of respondent No.1 is taken on record.

Main Case

This is a petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking issuance of a writ in the nature of Certiorari for quashing the order dated 09.07.2019 (Annexure P-6), whereby the service of the petitioner has been ordered to be discontinued w.e.f. 23.07.2019, with certain other prayers made in the present petition.

The counsel appearing for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner had since resigned from the job under the respondents. Hence, the present petition has been rendered infructuous qua the claim raised in the present petition. However, since the petitioner has actually worked with respondent No.2, therefore, the respondent No.2 should issue the certificate of experience to the petitioner.

In view of the above, the present petition is dismissed as having been rendered as infructuous qua the claim raised in the present petition.

However, the respondent No.2 is directed to issue the certificate of experience for the period for which the petitioner has actually worked with respondent No.2.

The pending miscellaneous applications, if any, are also disposed of as such.
