The prayer under Section 438 Cr.PC is for grant of anticipatory bail in case bearing FIR No.78 dated 27.05.2022 under Sections 420, 465, 467, 471, 120-B IPC registered at Police Station Dakha, District Ludhinana.

Learned Counsel for the petitioners submits that pursuant to the interim order dated 22.11.2022 passed by this Court, petitioner has joined the investigation.

The learned State Counsel on instructions from SI Sukhjinder Singh submits that the petitioner has joined investigation in terms of orders dated 22.11.2022 and is not required for custodial interrogation.

In this view of the matter, interim order dated 22.11.2022 is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall keep on joining the investigation

as and when required to do so and he shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
