The present petition has been filed with a prayer that the petitioner be granted the benefit equivalent to his junior i.e. respondent-Narsing.

After notice of motion, the reply has been filed by the respondents. In para 3 of the preliminary objections, the respondents have stated the following averments :-

“3. That the present Civil Writ Petition 'infructuous' because the 'relief' claimed for, has already been granted to the petitioner.”

On merits, the respondents have stated as under :-

“xxx xxx xxx xxx

12. That para No. 12 of the Civil Writ Petition is

matter of record. However, the case of the petitioner was duly considered by the competent Authority Chief Engineer (OP), UHBVN, Panchkula and the same benefit has already been granted to the petitioner vide office order No. 591/EPF-5543, dated 05.08.2015.”

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the above, as the relief has already been granted to the petitioner, no further orders are required to be passed in the present petition and the petition may kindly be disposed of as not pressed any further. Learned counsel for the petitioner prays that in case, petitioner has any grievance left for redressal, he be allowed to approach the respondents by filing appropriate representation and in case, such representation is filed by the petitioner raising any grievance, respondents be directed to decide the same by passing an appropriate order within a period of eight weeks of submission of the representation.
