1. The learned State counsel submits, that after completion of investigations, the investigating officer concerned has filed report under Section 173 Cr.P.C., before the learned trial Court concerned.
2. Consequently, when the above report, has been filed by investigating officer concerned, before the trial Court concerned, thereupon the investigations have come to an end. Therefore, the prayer made in the instant petition, for transfer of investigation to some other agency, than the one which carried them earlier, cannot be accepted, rendering rather for the afore reason, hence the petition to become completely infructuous. Consequently, the instant petition, for the afore prayer, is grossly mis-constituted, and, is dismissed as such.
3. However, liberty is reserved to the petitioner to, on all available grounds, ask for discharge, before the learned trial Judge concerned.
