1. Prayer in the petition is for initiating proceedings against the respondent for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P-1, dated 20.05.2022, CWP-10890-2022.

2. A perusal of order Annexure P/1 reveals that CWP-10890-2022, was disposed of by directing respondent No.5 herein to consider and decide representation dated 06.05.2022, in accordance with law, within two months, from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order and in case the petitioner was found entitled to the amount in question, to do the needful within further period of one month.

3. Learned counsel contends that pursuant to issuance of notice to respondent Nos.4 and 5, needful has been done, claim of the petitioner has been decided and payment as per entitlement released to the petitioner, therefore, in the circumstances, the petitioner is not interested

in pursuing the instant petition and may be permitted to withdraw the

same.

4. In view of the position noted above, as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is disposed of as not calling for any action against respondentNos.4 and 5 under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971.
