

**553 BEFORE THE BI-MONTHLY LOK ADALAT,
PUNJAB AND HARYANA HIGH COURT CHANDIGARH**

**FAO-183-2010
PARTAP VS RANJIT KUMAR AND ANR.**

On request, the instant matter taken in Bi-Monthly Lok Adalat, accordingly discussed.

As agreed, as per statements of learned counsel for the appellant and learned counsel of the Insurance Company (separately recorded), a sum of Rs.4,50,000/- (Rupees Four Lakhs and Fifty Thousand only) over and above the amount awarded by the Tribunal is allowed to the appellant in full and final settlement of the claim in this appeal.

Accordingly, we dispose of this case with a direction to the appellant to provide his bank details to respondent No.2-New India Assurance Company Limited within one week from today. Pursuant thereto, Insurance Company will deposit the agreed amount in the bank account of the appellant within two weeks thereafter. In case of failure to provide the bank account details by the appellant, the Insurance Company shall deposit a crossed-cheque for Rs.4,50,000/- (Rupees Four Lakhs and Fifty Thousand only) in the name of the appellant with the office of the Lok Adalat of the High Court within a period of one month, in compliance of this order, failing which, interest @ 9% per annum shall follow on this amount till payment from the date of this order. The concerned Officer of the Lok Adalat Branch/Office shall issue proper receipt after receiving the cheque to learned counsel/representative of the respondent-Insurance Company. The appellant may collect the cheque from the office of the Lok Adalat.

Copy of the order be supplied/sent to the counsel/parties and file be returned to the Hon'ble High Court.
