1. Prayer in the petition is for initiating proceedings against the respondent for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P-1, dated 07.12.2018, in CWP-31035-2018.

2. A perusal of order Annexure P/1 reveals that CWP-31035-2018, was disposed of by directing the respondents to decide legal notice dated 13.08.2018, by passing a speaking order within three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order and in case after the decision of the legal notice, the petitioner was found entitled to monetary benefits, to release the same to him within next three months.

3. Reply has been filed by the respondent denying relationship of employer-employee between the deceased husband of the petitioner and the University, resultantly, the orders of the High Court having been forwarded by the University to the Outsourcing Agency through whom the deceased husband of the petitioner had been employed and said

agency having paid Rs.3 Lakh to the petitioner, vide cheque No.188817 dated 15.05.2020 as evident from receipt in respect thereto dated 15.05.2020 issued by the petitioner in which the petitioner has also undertaken to withdraw the contempt petition. Copy of the reply along is taken on record. Copy thereof has already been supplied to learned counsel for the petitioner, who states that in view of the needful having been done, he does not press the instant petition and may be permitted to withdraw the same.

4. In view of the position noted above, as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is disposed of as not calling for any action against the respondents under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971.
