The petitioner has assailed the order dated 26.04.2022 whereby the petitioner has been directed to stop construction and remove violation in her dwelling unit within three days. The order further states that in case the ongoing construction is not stopped within three days, it would be demolished by the Chandigarh Housing Board at the risk and cost of the petitioner.

The contention of learned counsel for the petitioner is that the construction raised by the petitioner is compoundable. After passing of the aforesaid order dated 26.04.2022, she has submitted a representation dated 13.07.2022 (Annexure P/2) to the Secretary, Chandigarh Housing Board (exercising the powers of Chief Administrator).

Without going into the merits of the claim of the petitioner, this petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to take a decision on the representation Annexure P/2 within a period of four weeks. Till the decision is taken on the representation, the demolition of the construction raised by the petitioner shall remain stayed.
