1. The instant petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying for grant of extension of parole to the petitioner for two weeks.

As a special case, given the critical medical condition besetting the present petitioner, he may avail parole only upto 25.08.2022, but he shall positively surrender into the prison, on 26.08.2022, and, if he does not do so, thereupon, the jurisdictionally empowered police officer, shall cause his arrest, and, ensure that he is retrieved into the prison concerned.
