Vide this common order, three petitions, the details of which

have been given in the heading, are being disposed of as common question

of law arises in all of them.

Learned counsels for the petitioners submit that the petitioners have a genuine grievance with regard to the change of cut off date from 31.03.2022 to 31.08.2022 by the respondents as a lot of employees will be suffering their transfers due to this action of the respondents, despite the fact that as per the original Transfer Policy, the petitioners were not compulsorily supposed to participate in the said transfer drive.

Learned counsels for the petitioners further submit that even by taking a compassionate point of view, the hardship of the petitioners can be reviewed by the respondents, and therefore, the petitioners may kindly be given liberty to approach the respondents for redressal of their grievances by way of filing the appropriate representations before the authorities concerned.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Harish Nain, AAG, Haryana, keeping in view the advance service of the copies of petitions, accepts notice on behalf of the State and submits that in case any such representations are filed by the petitioners before the authorities concerned, the same will be considered in accordance with law and after consideration, if the petitioners are found meritorious, the appropriate speaking orders will be passed within a period of ten days from the date of receipt of such representations.

At this stage, learned counsels for the petitioners submit that keeping in view the submissions of learned State counsel, as recorded hereinbefore, no further grievances of the petitioners survive in the present petitions at this stage and the same may kindly be disposed of as having been not pressed any further at this stage with the liberty as prayed for.
