The instant application has been filed under Section 151 of the Code of Civil Procedure, seeking preponement of the date of hearing in the main writ petition which is fixed for 12.01.2023. It has been averred in the application that during the pendency of the main writ petition, fresh election of the Governing Body of Vatika City Apartment Owners Association – petitioner has already been held as per bye-laws and new Governing Body has been elected and the new Governing Body has also got approval from the District Registrar, Firms and Societies, Haryana, Gurugram, Haryana. He thus contends that he has instructions to withdraw the main writ petition

itself. He further contends that no separate instructions from the office bearers of the erstwhile Governing Body is required. The application is supported by an affidavit of Mr. Satyavan Dagar who is the President of the New elected Governing Body.

Notice of the application.

Mr. Pankaj Mulwani, DAG, Haryana, accepts notice and he has no objection to the instant application being allowed.

Consequently, the present application is allowed. The main writ petition is preponed from 12.01.2023 and is taken on board today itself.

Main case

In view of the separate application having been moved for withdrawal of the main writ petition which is not objected to by the respondent - State, the present writ petition is dismissed as withdrawn.

Pending misc. applications, if any, shall also stand disposed of accordingly.
