Main case

This petition has been filed by the petitioner under Section 438 Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.118 dated 22.06.2019, under Sections 307, 506, 323, 34 of IPC and Section 25 of Arms Act (Sections 27 and 30 of Arms Act added later on) registered at Police Station: Nathana, District Bathinda.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has argued that the petitioner was summoned under Section 319 Cr.P.C and apprehending his arrest, he approached this Court through this petition. Learned counsel has invited the attention of this Court to the order dated

14.12.2021 and submitted that the concession of interim protection was extended to him subject to his submitting himself before the trial Court. Learned counsel has stated that in compliance of the direction dated 14.12.2021, the petitioner submitted himself before the trial Court, who was admitted on interim regular bail. In this regard, he has drawn the attention of the Court to the order dated 22.12.2021 (Annexure A-1) passed by the trial Court.

Learned State counsel does not dispute this fact and states that the petitioner submitted himself before the trial Court within time and was admitted on bail.

Considering the above, the petition is allowed and it is ordered that the petitioner shall remain on regular bail and on the same bail bonds/surety bonds furnished by him before the trial Court on 22.12.2021.
